8. General business

a) Professional Standards and Complaints Committee

The 2015 AGM established a Committee to oversee the association's professional standards and to receive and address any complaints. The committee handles any matters referred to it by video conference and on the papers unless otherwise agreed by the Committee members.

At the 2015 - 2017 AGMs it was delegated to the Board the responsibility of appointing members of the Professional Standards and Complaints Committee after a specific complaint was received. This would ensure that the members of the Committee were appropriate to consider the complaint and hove no conflicts of interest.

To date there have been no formal complaints received that have had to been referred to the Professional Standards and Complaints Committee. Complaints received have been addressed or resolved)

The policy and procedure for handling complaints has proven to have some weaknesses which need to be addressed. These are addressed in a revision of the policy previously approved by the 2015 AGM. Code of Conduct matters are considered matters to be addressed by the members at an AGM.

Recommendation

That Policy and Procedure 10 "Bioenergy Association Professional Standards and Complaints Committee" (version dated 18 September 2018) be approved.

b) Membership fees

The current membership levels were set a number of years ago and have not been changed since. Membership fees currently are:

Gold \$5000 plus GST Silver \$2000 plus GST Bronze \$520 plus GST

It is proposed that the Bronze membership level be increased to \$600 plus GST.

Recommendation

That the Bronze membership level be increased to \$600 plus GST from 1 April 2019.
