The Forum will take place in Auckland and will also be presented online.

Switzerland has become one of the world's leaders in the fields of waste management and recycling. Highly innovative companies and research institutions, combined with environmental law dating back to the 1980s, have forced private households and public authorities to recycle material and treat waste in a sustainable manner. Designated plants, using highly sophisticated and constantly evolving modern technology, now treat and process waste streams.

We would like to invite you to join us at the Forum, where a 3D virtual tour to three Swiss waste to energy plants will take place. The tour will be followed by a panel discussion with experts, who will provide information and answers to questions on the technology and processes seen at the plants. Emphasis at the forum will be placed on:

- Outlining the situation of daily waste management: recycling and landfills in New Zealand.
- 3D virtual tour through waste to energy plants (please see attached separate description).
- Demonstration of the recycling of bottom ash from waste to energy plants.
- An opportunity to put questions to the expert panel from Switzerland.

People who attend the Virtual Forum in Auckland will be able to take the virtual tour using VR goggles. An attendance cap applies at the venue in Auckland, where light refreshments will be provided. Online attendance is open, and participants will be able to follow the tour and actively take part in the panel discussion. There is no cost for attending the Forum, either in Auckland or online.
