Key Research Programme - Biomass to Syngas and Liquid Fuels (BTSL) - A research and development programme led by <a href="Professor Shusheng Pang">Professor Shusheng Pang</a>, Chemical and Process Engineering (CAPE), University of Canterbury (UoC), and funded by industry and the New Zealand Ministry of Business, Innovation & Employment (MBIE) from 2008 to 2015. The programme consists of 5 tasks:

- Biomass gasification and co-gasification of biomass and coal
- Development of gas cleaning technologies
- Biomass pyrolysis and gasification of pyrolysis bio-oil/char slurry
- Fischer-Tropsch synthesis for liquid fuels
- New biomass resources and feasibility study of the system from biomass to liquid fuels
